### **Searching iDiscover**

iDiscover is our online catalalogue at Cambridge University. You can find all the books, journals, articles, ebooks and databases you will during your stay at Cambridge University.

You can borrow from **Christ's Library**, <u>Your Departmental Library</u> and the <u>University Library</u>.

#### Searching iDiscover

- 1. In the search bar put identifiable words from the title and author name.
- 2. Filter to Christ's Library (on right). Your search could still bring many results but hopefully your book is in the top results. Keep filtering.
- 3. Click on the tilte of the book which will bring you to the individual book information.
- 4. Scroll to the middle of the page where there is a list of all the libraries that hold the book.
- 5. Find Christ's library and check availability. Note down the floor and the classmark (letter- number code next to the location).
- 6. Come to the library to pick the book up from the shelves or staff can reserve it for you library@christs.cam.ac.uk
- 7. For ebooks and articles simply follow the iDiscover links to the host page.

## **Searching iDiscover**

iDiscover has many features to help you through the hundreds of results with each search

### **Top Search Tips**

- Like Google search you only need identifiable words from your title and author of the book
- iDiscover has filters (on right) where you can filter for Christ's only material, availability etc.
- You can differentiate your search between book or online material like an ebook or article (options on search bar)
- If you know what you are looking you can use Advance Search (top right of search bar)
- Save your searches or book information by logging into your library account and then pinning the information



### Additional features of iDiscover

Create references, email- print-export-save your book information.



### **Your Library Account**

#### Your Library Account

Log into your Library account on the top right of your iDiscover page (<u>idiscover.lib.cam.ac.uk</u>), to check loans, due dates and fines. You can also renew books, check any requests and saved book information or searches. You will need your Raven password.

#### How do I find library materials?

All items in the Working Library are listed in iDiscover, which can also be used to search across the entire University's collections.



iDiscover will tell you the shelfmark of the item you have been seeking, which you can then use to find it:

#### What if someone already has the book I need?

If you want an item that is currently on loan, you can use the 'request' button on iDiscover to request it. You'll be notified by email when the book is returned, and you can pick it up from the 'Recalled Books and Book Requests' shelf by the Reading Room entrance.
